

HOW TO: Clean your terrazzo tiles



Terrazzo tiles can develop stains when stored outside in piles. This is due to fungus that thrive on humidity and the lack of oxygen.

Removing these stains is relatively easy:

- First, place the tiles in a **dry and warm** environment for some hours. The process will be faster if the environment is dryer and warmer. In a typical living room it takes about 24 hours. This time can be half as long if the tiles can be placed outside on a dry and sunny day for instance.
- After drying, the fungus can easily be removed with water and bleach ('eau de javel'). Soda crystals also work and are more eco-friendly. All traces of fungus will disappear without leaving stains.
