Provenance

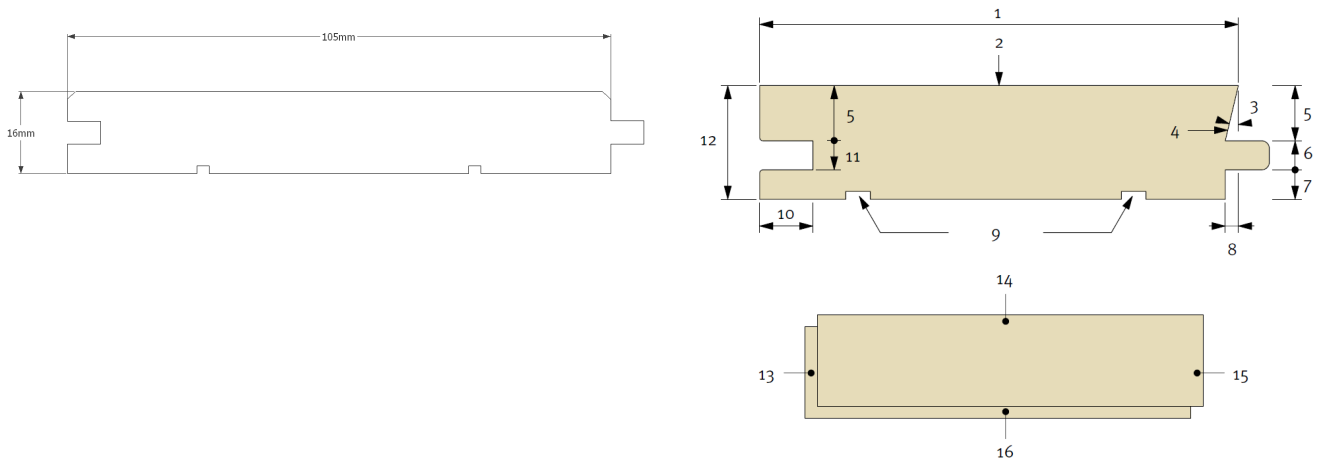
The parquet is made from beech wood harvested within 35 km from the Grand' Place of Brussels. The wood was acquired from a family estate in Braine L'Alleud, more specifically from the woods called Bois Planté and Tasnière in the winter 2022/2023.
